B) Number Of Candidate: - The maximum number of candidate to be examined in Clinical / Practical and oral shall not exceed 8 per batch of two days examination.

<u>C)</u> <u>Criteria for examiner</u>: - All the Post Graduate Examiners shall be recognized Post Graduate Teachers holding recognized Post Graduate qualifications in the subject concerned with minimum 5 yrs P.G. Teaching experience.

<u>D) Number of Examiners for Practical</u>: -There shall be four examiners: Two Internal and two external. Internal 1: - Same centre (Convenor) Internal 2: - Out side the college within same region. External 1: - Within MUHS from other region.

External 2: - Outside state, if not available then, outside MUHS jurisdiction within state.

Following methods are used to assess the learning outcomes and graduate attributes.

1. Ongoing evaluation: The institute conducts regular internal evaluation (IA)

The students' outcome is assessed through the theory and practical IA performance.

- 2. University Exams: Each year one final exam is conducted by university .The pattern is uniform for all students in Maharashtra. The final course outcome is assessed through the performance in the exams
- 3. Case presentations: The UG and PG program has clinical postings, which involves supervised evaluation and patient care. PGs and interns independently take assessment and plan the treatment, the outcome of the patient care is assessed through the case presentation. It's mandatory for the student to fulfill a minimum no of cases in each year which is prescribed by MUHS. The students' performance is measured through an evaluation format and scorings.PG students are evaluated by a checklist given by university.
- 4. Seminar /EBP presentation: Regular class seminars and presentations are taken for UG and PG students. PG students are given topics for seminars. Their performance is assessed thru feedback form and scoring by the faculty.

- 5. Assignments: All UG and PG students are given assignments on related topic in classroom as well as clinics. These assignments are given in oral, on TEAMS, in written format or thru google forms as per the requirement of topic.
- 6. Log Books: PG students are supposed to maintain a Log Book which keeps a record of their yearly performance. This is as per prescribed format of MUHS.
- 7. Practical Journals: UG students are supposed to maintain a Journal in which they write the practical procedures. This journal carries certain marks for university and internal exams.
- 8. OSPE / OSCE: Method of examination is used to assess the skill of students in the internal exams.
- 9. Dissertation- PG students have to carry out a project and submit dissertation to university thru college in order to be eligible to appear for final exam. It carries 50 marks in their final exam.
- 10. Projects- UG students and interns have to do projects. Synopsis is to be submitted final year. Submission and viva related to it carries marks in their final exam of community PT. Data collection and project writing is to be done in internship. This is mandatory for getting internship completion certificate from university.
