- 1.2 To do all things necessary to complete the project to the extent necessary and to collect and analyze the data for expected outcome measures.


2. ARRANGEMENT



Training details: This training module was taken to educate and prepare the aarogya maitrin for providing specified exercises to people of her community, who have been identified with musculoskeletal problems. The aarogya maitrin was shown exercises for 4 commonly affected regions of the body: the neck, shoulder, low back and knee. She was then asked for her preference amongst these exercise sets. Later the aarogya maitrin was asked to perform the exercises herself and was supervised by the MPT students and staff members. Necessary instructions and corrections were provided to the aarogya maitrin while she showed the exercises. They too cleared their doubts. - (h) not to do or permit to be done anything upon the premises of the said Hospital and its precincts which may be a nuisance, annoyance or disturbance to the patients and inmates of the said Hospital or to the owners, occupiers or residents of other premises in the vicinity.


