Q 1 (a) Pediatric Facial Palsy--

Answer Facial palsy is caused due to damage to facial nerve

Clinical features-

The symptoms are unilateral

Drooping of eyelid or ptosis.

Usually seen in pediatric population.

Caused due to pressure by Forceps Blade on facial nerve at exit from stylomastoid foramen, course over mandibular ramus.

- Appears within 1-2 days of delivery with residual oedema and haemorrhage around nerve.
- Paresis of facial muscles on affected side
- Partially opened eye
- Flattening of nasolabial fold.
- Mouth angle deviated towards healthy side.

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
