Both of them guided the students who showed interested in studying and working in the USA in the future .

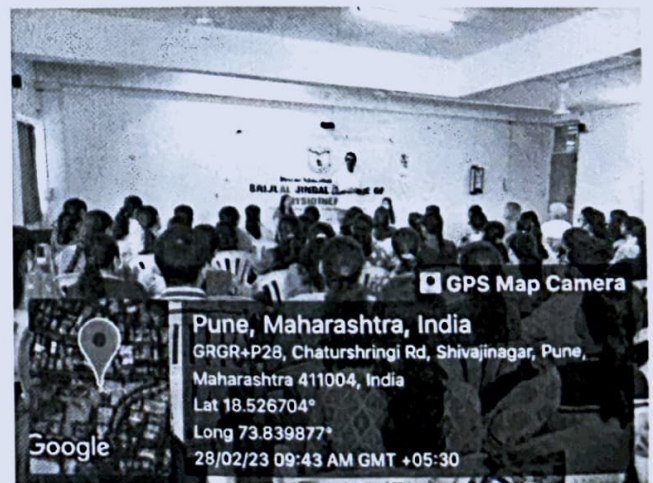
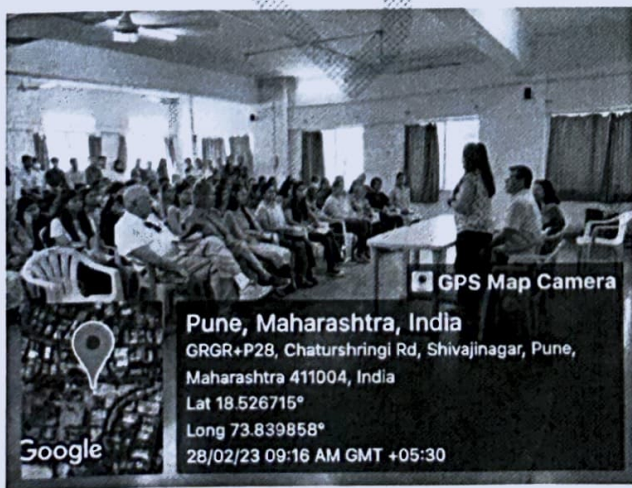

Vaccination camp was arranged by the college for all students and the booster dose was given free of ~~setting~~ cost.

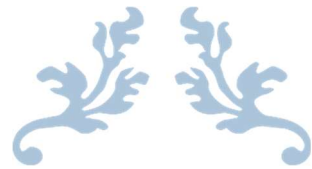






Our 2nd year exams were scheduled on time as per every year in the month of March.

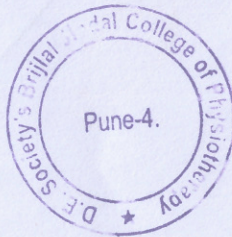

Feedback on the online exams:



- Students were advised carry dry breakfast items like chivda/ladoo/cereals/fruits etc which can be useful in case of emergency


