(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

## WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a renowned institution located in Pune offering comprehensive and cuttingedge education in the field of physiotherapy:

## Deccan Education Society's Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy, Pune

B) Established with a vision to foster excellence in physiotherapy education, research, and clinical practice, BICP has been providing top-quality education to aspiring physiotherapists for over a decade.
C) Second Party is Mahavir Enterprises
D) Mahavir Enterprises is a leading business enterprise located in Pune, specializing in manufacturing and distribution of orthoties and prosthetics products and services and is a trusted and reliable provider of high-quality orthotic and prosthetic products.
E) First Party \& Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
F) The Parties intent to promote mutual understanding, cooperation, and coordination in the areas of educatión, research, and professional development related to physiotherapy and prosthetics/orthotics.
G) Both Parties desire to sign this MOU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

## NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

## CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish
channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advane respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall each other informed of potential opportunities that may be relevant to secure additio opportunities for one another.
1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to themin developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party,
1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU, The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant MoUs, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU, The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

## CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 Cooperation for Student Benefit: The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the stadent community to enhance their skills and knowledge. Both Parties will collaborate to develop and implement joint educational and training programs, workshops, seminars, and other educational activities for students, faculty, and professionals in the field of physiotherapy and prosthetics/ortholics.
2.2 Internships and Placement of Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.
2.3 Foot Specialty Clinic: Both parties will collaborate to set up a Foot Specialty Clinic as follows -
2.3.1. First party shall be responsible to provide appropriate space that is accessible to the needs of the target, appropriate furniture and peripherals for supporting consulting of patients and day to day conduct of operations of such a facility, and maintenance necessary for the upkeep of the facility.
2.3.2. The Second Party shall provide equipment and expertise for the practical training and skill development of physiotherapy students, under the supervision of qualified professionals and also the consulting of patients.
2.3.3. The second party shall be responsible for billing to patients, and will share $10 \%$ of the bill amount with the first party at month end, in a transparent and fair manner.
2.3.4. Second party will submit monthly reports of the activities of the Foot Clinic as per the institutional requirement of the First Party, in a format which is communicated to the Second Party at the beginning of the activities of the Foot Clinic.
2.3.5. Both parties will communicate regularly to discuss all matters of relevance and make efforts towards the development of the center activities.
2.4 Sensory Garden - Both parties recognize the importance of creating inclusive spaces for individuals with sensory processing challenges, such as those with autism or other sensory sensitivities, to enhance their physical, mental, and emotional well-being through sensory gardens. Both parties shall jointly develop and implement a sensory garden project that integrates physiotherapy principles, prosthetics/orthotics expertise, and sensory stimulation techniques to benefit differently abled individuals, as follows -
2.4.1. The parties will work together to design the layout, select appropriate sensory elements, and identify suitable prosthetics/orthotics products or adaptations for the sensory garden, taking into consideration the safety, accessibility, and sensory needs of the target population.
2.4.2. The Second Party may provide the necessary prostheties/orthotics products or adaptations, technical expertise, and guidance to ensure that the sensory garden meets the highest standards of quality, safety, and effectiveness.
2.4.3. The First shall be responsible to provide location that should be easily accessible to the target users and comply with accessibility standards.
2.4.4. Both parties shall work out a detailed facility creation and operational plan for the establishment and running of the sensory garden, with clearly laid down tasks, responsibilities and obligations.

### 2.5 Mobility Aids:

2.6 Research and Development: Both Parties shall collaborate on research projects, clinical trials, and innovation initiatives in the field of physiotherapy and prosthetics/orthotics. The parties may share resources, data, and expertise for research and innovation activities, subject to mutual consent and applicable laws and regulations. The results of joint research and innovation projects may be disseminated through publications, presentations, or other
appropriate means, with due acknowledgement to the parties involved.
2.7 Professional Development: Both Parties shall collaborate to provide professid devclopment opportunities, training programs, and certifications for physiotherapisis ant professionals in the field of prosthetics/orthotics. The purties may organize joint workshops, conferences, and seminars on relevant topics to promote knowledge exchange and skill enhancement among healthcare professionals.
Entrepreneurship Development: Both parties shall make best efforts to support new ideas, startups, and aspiring entrepreneurs with knowledge and access to resources so that innovative ideas can be transformed into successful business ventures,
29 Mentoring: Both parties shall actively engage to facilitate and promote mentoring of students to expose students to new products and new ideas. Second Party may provide support in the form of mentorship, guidance, and expertise to physiotherapists and students associated with the First Party to enhance their professional skills and knowledge.
2.10 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
2.11 Both parties may establish a reporting and monitoring mechanism to track the progress and outcomes of all collaborative activitics.
2.12 The parties may agree on regular reporting intervals and reporting formats to ensure effective communication, transparency, and accountability in the collaborative partnership.
2.13 There is no financial commitment on the part of both parties to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

## CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in cither Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.
3.2 The incidental IPR created because of this MoU and activities under its umbrella will be shared after case to case considerations not limited to knowhow, inventions, patents, copyrights and design.

## CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

4.1 This MoU will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of the Second Party after termination of this MoU by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an
extension of this MOU
4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

## CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, 10 make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make MoUs of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Pune.

Entrepreneurship Development Center, an Indian Non-profit Company registered under section 8 of The Companies Act-1956, having its registered offico at 100, NCL Innovation Park, CSIR-NCL Campus, Dr. Homi Bhabha Road, Pune-411008, Maharashtra, India, hereinafter referred to as Venture Center, which expression shall unless repugnant to context include its successors, executors and assignees,

Both herein after referred to as the "Partics" collectively, or "Party" individually.

## 1. PREAMBLE

0 TVMRREAS Venture Center is a non- profit technology business incubator (TB1) hosted by CSIR-
SUOHME Ghemical Laboratory, Pune specializing in science and technology based startups in a wide array of parket ctors and scientific disciplines. Venture Center is a TBI created under a scheme of CSIR (GAvernmert of India), approved by DST-NSTEDB (MoS\&T, Govt of India). Venture Center is recognisat a NIDHI-Center of Excellence by DST-NSTEDB. Venture Center is also a BIRAC (Depargigit of Biotechnology, Govt of India) supported bio incubator that is nurturing several biotechyoiomed startups and imnovators. BIRAC has selected Venture Center to host the BIRAC Regional Biolnnovation Center and the Center for Biopharma Analysis. Venturs Center has been awarded the National Award for Technology Business Incubators from the President of India on 11 May 2016, the AABI (Asian) Incubator of the Year 2018 and National Entrepreneurship Award under the Ecosystem Builder Category 2019 and National Award for best Incubator for nurturing IP 2021-22

WHEREAS Venture Center has formed a technology transfer hub -TechEx.in with support from the National Biopharma Mission (NBM) - an initiative of Biotechnology Industry Rescarch Assisfance Council (BIRAC) and Department of Biotechnology (Government of India), to help and assist inventors and technology developers seek formal IP protection, market their technologies, belp technology developers and technology commercialization entities find each other, forge parmerships and advance the technology closer to the market in a win-win partnership.

WHEREAS D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy has plans to strengthen its

innovation promotion, IP protection and technology commercialization capabilities and has expressed an interest in engaging with partners with complementing activities and interests.

WHEREAS, given the commonality of objectives, Venture Center has agreed to make accessible its various TechEx.in services to D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy as mentioned in Appendix 1.

Given the complementarities of their objectives and aligned interests, the Parties therefore decided to enter into a MoU to secure those objectives by mutual cooperation.

## 2. INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS

Subject to the context hereof the following words and expressions shall be construed and interpreted so is to have the following meaning.
2.1 Effective Date: shall mean the date of signing of this agreement by both parties.
2.2 Technology: shall mean D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy technical know how, teclunical knowledge and information, and/or patents and patent applications.

IP: Intellectual Property shall mean Knowhow, confidential information, Patents, trademarks, Industrial Designs and IC Layout Designs and Copyrights if any.

## TERM OF MOU

3.1 This MoU shall remain in force for a period 12 months from the Effective date.
3.2 The term of the MoU as specified in 3.1 may be extended to such further terms as mutually decided by the parties in consultation with each other, which shall not be more than 35 months in all including the first 12 months.

## 4. SCOPE OF MOU

4.1 Veature Center agrees to partner with D.E. Socicty Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy and D.E. Socicty agrees to accept VentureCenter as a partner.
4.2 Both Venture Center and D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy agree to designate one nodal person from each side to coordinate and facilitate implementation of this MoU. On behalf of D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy, Dr. Snehal Joshi will be the nodal person as point of contact. On behalf of Venture Center, Dr. Kavita Parekh will be the nodal person as point of contact. The relationship under this MoU shall be mutually non-exclusive.

### 4.3 Respensibiliticsonf Venture Center


4.3.1 Venture Center agrees to invite D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy for all the open talks, seminars and events,
4.3.2 Venture Center will arrange and announce free of cost mentoring and advisory clinics open to all its Strategic Partners including the D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy. The mentoring clinics will be held roughly once a month. D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Pbysiotherapy will be required to signup for the above clinics and book the slots on a first come as per availability.
4.3.3 Venture Center agrees to make accessible discounted TechEx.in services (as listed in the Appendix1) to D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy subject to a) availability, b) D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy agreeing to all terms \& conditions applicable to specific services and c) payment of applicable fees. The D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy may or may not choose to avail of these services as per requirement and as allowed by its rules.
4.3.4 Venture Center will provide access to occasional funding support for patent filing and/ or fect transfer training announced by NBM-BIRAC as and when available.

4.4.3 In order to reduce any misunderstandings or duplication of work, the D.E. Society Brijlal Jindal College of Physiotherapy shall inform Venture Center of any parallel efforts by other purtners'/ service providers with regards to services offered by Venture Center.
4.5 Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MOU.

5.1 Parties shall initiate discussions by sharing non-confidential information first.

The mediator fees shall be shared equally between both parties.
